

Wambalang Environmental Education Centre Overnight Information

Facilities

The centre has:

- 2 dormitories for overnight accommodation for 50 students
- Separate teachers' room for 7 teachers
- Fully equipped kitchen with fridges, freezers, dishwasher, gas oven and microwave.
- All cooking and eating utensils supplied
- Dining room with heating and air-conditioning
- Bathrooms with hot showers
- Extensive lawns, a playground and volley ball court
- Aviary, worm farms and Gauri the carpet python
- Night time access to classroom and smartboard
- Fire pit and wood
- Outdoor barbeque and covered eating area.



Programs

Wambangalang is an exciting place to come for an overnight camp for 1-4 nights from Monday to Thursday. Overnight camps provide opportunities for students to

- Develop team building skills
- Learn about the natural environment
- Develop personal skills of self-reliance, cooperation and independence
- Enjoy new learning experiences with peers in a different environment.

The camps activities can be planned to suit the needs and learning outcomes of the students. **Day** programs can be included as part of the program.

Occupational Health and Safety

To ensure the safety and health of students, teachers will follow the DET Guidelines.

- Complete the Wambangalang risk assessment sheet and return
- The Wambangalang staff do not stay overnight.
- If boys and girls are staying then a male and female teacher need to stay overnight
- Teacher/student ratio is approximately 1/15 on overnight visits
- A minimum of 2 teachers are required to stay.
- It is preferable that a vehicle is kept here on site during the camp in case of emergencies.
- It is the responsibility of the staff to supervise the students in the evening and overnight.
- The staff are responsible for the administering of medication and welfare of the students on overnight camps. Medical conditions will have been recorded on the booking sheets. A First Aid kit is available in the school.
- The centre will follow the NSW Department of Education & Training of no drugs, alcohol or gambling in schools and students will be disciplined accordingly.
